

Notice Regarding the Processing of Donors' Personal Data

- 1. The data controller for personal data is Fundacja ASWfor Foundation, located in Bielawa, ul. Warszawska 202, 05-520 Konstancin-Jeziorna.

- 3. The processing of your personal data by the Foundation occurs on the following legal bases:
 - Article 6(1)(b) GDPR If you make a financial donation (regardless of the payment channel used), we process your personal data upon your request to register the payment or payment history.
 - Article 6(1)(f) GDPR To fulfill the legitimate interests of the data controller, which include fulfilling our mission of educating new generations to change the world for the better.
- 4. Your personal data will only be shared, to the necessary extent, with government and local authorities that are legally entitled to request such data, as well as contractors, service providers, and subcontractors working on behalf of the Foundation to achieve its legitimate objectives.
- 5. Donors' personal data will be processed until the dissolution of the Foundation or until you object to the processing of your data.
- 6. After the aforementioned period, your data will be deleted or anonymized in accordance with archival regulations.
- 7. Personal data will not be processed automatically, except for classification within an electronic database.
- 8. The Foundation processes standard personal data.
- 9. You have the right to request the following from the data controller:
- · Access to your personal data,
- Rectification of your personal data,
- Erasure of your personal data,
- Restriction of the processing of your personal data,
- Object to the processing of your personal data,
- Portability of your personal data.
- 11. You also have the right to file a complaint with the supervisory authority the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection (Prezes Urzędu Ochrony Danych Osobowych).
- 12. Providing personal data is voluntary, but failure to provide such data may hinder the fulfillment of the legitimate objectives of the data controller.
